

# New Hampshire Health Profession Opportunity Project (HPOP)

## How Can I Participate In HPOP?

To find out if you qualify and to apply for the Health Profession Opportunity Project (HPOP) please follow these steps:

1. **Call 603-410-3347 to register** for an Information Session.

2. **Attend an HPOP Information Session** to learn about the program objectives, benefits of participation, eligibility requirements, and application process.

3. **Gather and submit supporting documentation to verify eligibility** (see Eligibility Verifications List). To be eligible, individuals must meet age, legal status, and financial requirements:

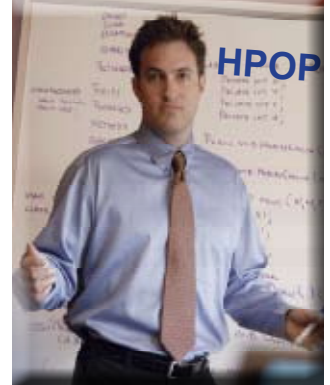
- Age: Adults, 18 years of age or older
- Legal Status: U.S. Citizens, legal residents of five (5) years, refugees, and other eligible non-citizens
- Financial: There are four (4) potential categories based on family/ household earnings:
  - Currently receiving Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
  - Receiving “Food Stamps,” Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
  - Low income under 185% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
  - Currently working in the healthcare field and earning up to 300% FPL



4. **Submit an application and complete basic academic testing to be considered for acceptance into the program.** HPOP Case Managers will provide assistance with the application as needed.

Final candidates will be invited to interviews and notified whether they have been selected to participate in HPOP.
